

Neuropathic Toe Ulcerations

39 year old male. History of diabetes (Type 1); **3 toes amputated 4 years ago** on right foot and **plantar foot ulcer [forefoot] 2 years ago with time to heal of 1.5 years**; new ulcerations on left foot due to new shoes and lack of tissue damage sensation (neuropathy); Antibiotics and SWC for **6 months with no improvement**; entered wound care clinic as outpatient due to continued infection and degradation of wound tissues; continued on antibiotics and started on EpiFLO therapy with **healing achieved by 3 weeks**.



Week 0: Pre-EpiFLO; Left toe ulcerations (6-month history with recent onset of infection)



Week 3: EpiFLO therapy (occlusive dressing 'tented' [inset] holding oxygen regionally) - healing of ulcerations and improvement of surrounding tissues
