

# Diabetic Foot Ulcer + Osteomyelitis

## Non-Continuous EpiFLO TSOT

83 year old male. Diabetes (Type II); Outpatient 6 months; Open lesion left foot / 1<sup>st</sup> MT phalangeal joint [wound previously open for 1 month (dime size)] with development of osteomyelitis.

Prior Treatments: Fibrocal, Combiderm adhesive, Aquacel Ag; antibiotics Cipro, Clindamycin.

**BREAK IN EpiFLO THERAPY FOR 1 MONTH: Daily SWC by community nursing**  
**EpiFLO re-initiated due to significant wound regression**

**Week 0:** 2 x 2 cm  
Depth: 3-4 mm

**Week 1:** 1.5 x 1.0 cm  
Depth: 2-3 mm

**Week 0':** 1.25 x 0.8 cm  
Depth: 2-3 mm  
Margins undermined: 3-4mm

**Week 2':** 0.8 x 0.5 cm  
Depth: 1-2 mm  
No undermining / healing re-started (ongoing therapy)
